The Evolution has easy to use controls and is designed for low maintenance. Its shallow appearance allows it to fit in small spaces and the generous 160 in² glass size provides maximum viewing of the fire and the steel brick firebox.

- The auger is cushioned to reduce motor noise.
- The stove can operate efficiently with the convection fan turned off.
- The combustion fan is strategically positioned inside the stove to minimize its noise level. However, our engineers have also made it possible for you to install the combustion fan outside your home to further help suppress noise.

These features combine to create the quietest pellet stove in the world - all you should hear is the pellet fuel gently dropping into the firebox.
